

- No doctoral project proposal required prior to admission

- A Master's degree, or equivalent, with a 2.5 cumulative grade point average
- Students from non-business backgrounds applying to the DBA program must take ORG 500 Organizational Behavior and FIN 500 Financial & Accounting Skills for Managers as prerequisite courses.

DBA Program Credit Hours



- The DBA program consists of a total program requirement of 60 credit hours
- Duration: 3 years
- Students take 1 course per 8-week session
- 6 transfer credits from ISM are possible, if the student participates in the ISM seminar week
